



Potential candidates should be willing to speak for and advocate the Foundation's mission and further the cause for public education in Loudoun County Public Schools.

Potential candidate must be willing to serve on, at a minimum, the committee that will best use their skills.

Fiduciary experience and willingness to accept the responsibilities of stewardship inherent in the 501(c) status of the Foundation.

Broad contacts that can assist Foundation management with raising funds either corporately, individually, or from other foundations or governments.

An ability and willingness to assist and advocate for the Foundation financially, such as through membership in other foundations, corporate involvement, or other acts.

An ability to recruit and retain high quality board members.

The Board should consist of individuals with a diversity of interests and backgrounds, with a goal to balance as many interests as possible while advancing and broadening the strength of the Board, and the Foundation.

Potential candidates should be residents of or have significant business or community interests in Loudoun County and the Loudoun County Public Schools

Potential candidates are expected to attend at least 75% of the board, committee, and special meetings scheduled each year or make an equivalent contribution of resources to the foundation.

Potential candidates should be willing to speak to the board as to why they want to be a director, and their value proposition to LEF.

Approval of candidates will be by a 75% of the voting members present.
