

Loudoun Education Foundation Apple Impact Grant Program

Program Description and Application Instructions

Grants Available

- Loudoun Education Foundation will award Apple Impact classroom grants to LCPS teachers through its Teacher Grant Program.
- Teachers may submit proposals for projects they will implement during the current school year.
- The maximum grant awarded to a project is \$2,500; there is no minimum amount.

Eligibility

- Applications must be submitted by the person(s) who will implement the proposed project.
- Applications for the \$2,500 grant must be either multi-disciplinary, multi-grade, multi-school, or involve participation by an entire grade and benefit a significant number of students.

Award Criteria

Primary consideration will be given to proposals that:

- Involve and/or affect as many students as possible;
- Benefit a diverse student group;
- Are creative and innovative;
- Supplement and/or enhance the standard curriculum and ordinary teaching methods;
- Support a program or project with measurable results;
- Promote inter-classroom, interdisciplinary and/or joint teacher projects;

Proposals will **NOT** be considered if they:

- Compensate LCPS personnel (includes professional development/substitutes);
- Provide money for materials or supplies ordinarily included in the LCPS budget;
- Are not in conformance with stipulated goals of a curriculum area or course of study;
- Require ongoing maintenance;
- Are used to purchase food or student incentive items;
- Do not provide a **detailed budget**.

Application Process

- Download and complete the Application Form. (*Note: Submissions must be computer-generated or typed.*)
- Obtain all the required signatures before submitting the proposal.
- Submit **one** printed copy of your proposal with original signatures.
- Limit the application packet to no more than five (5) **single-sided** pages plus lesson plan.
- Adhere to the deadlines.
- Provide a **DETAILED BUDGET**.

Application Availability and Submission

- Applications are available at www.loudouneducationfoundation.org under the Grants tab.
- Applications must be received by Close of Business on the date stipulated on the front of the application form. (*Note: Application may be scanned in and emailed to lruss@lcps.org*)

Selection Process

- All proposals received by the deadline are screened for adherence to criteria prior to being forwarded for review by the Loudoun Education Foundation Grant & Awards Committee. (Proposals received after the deadline will be returned to the Contact Teacher.)
- Applications will be provided to the appropriate discipline supervisors for their review and comments.
- Awards are made in accordance with the guidelines above. Applicants will be notified of the Grant & Award Committee's decisions as soon as possible.
- Grant recipients are required to submit a summary report no later than 60 days following the completion of the project.
