


# Working Together to Bring Down Barriers

Thanks to the Loudoun County Public Schools Instruction Leadership Team for rolling up its sleeves to help pack 995 Backpack Coalition meal bags for students in need!

From a warehouse in Leesburg, the bags were delivered to 22 schools throughout Loudoun County.

Each bag includes a protein, fruit, vegetable, and side options such as rice and lentils, and provides enough food to feed the student and their family over the weekend. Each school's family liaison discretely slips the meals into the backpacks of food-insecure students.

**Backpack Coalition** also supports 11 in-school pantries, providing students with much-needed meals and snacks.
